INSURANCES

It may not cover the total cost of your bill. Most plans cover between 50-80 percent of dental services, up to a minimum allowance.

Pizza Casserole!

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 pkg. onion soup mix
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 green pepper, diced
- 2 cups elbow spaghetti
- 1 (4 oz. can) mushrooms
- 4 oz. pepperoni, diced
- 1 (14-1/2 oz.) can pizza sauce
- 8 oz. shredded mozzarella

Cook spaghetti and brown beef and set aside.

Combine soup mix, water, green pepper and cook until green pepper is tender.

Add spaghetti, browned beef, mushrooms, pepperoni and pizza sauce. Put in a casserole dish, sprinkle with cheese and bake at 350° for 30 minutes and then ENJOY!!
